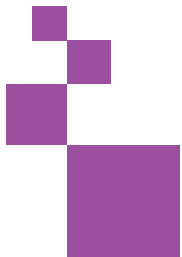


WAGE SUBSIDY

EMPLOI-QUÉBEC



Looking for a job? You could receive the **Wage Subsidy**, which can help open doors with potential employers.

This subsidy, which is paid to the employer, will help you access lasting employment or gain work experience. You could also receive training or personalized coaching to help you join the workforce.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, you must

- be unemployed
- be experiencing difficulties in joining the labour market

You could receive additional support to help you find lasting employment thanks to the **Wage Subsidy for Older Workers**, if you are

- aged 55 or over, or
- aged 50 or over and a social-assistance or social-solidarity recipient

TO APPLY

You must first meet with an assistance officer at your local employment centre to **assess your needs**. The assessment will make it possible to determine whether the **Wage Subsidy** is the best way to help you find a job.

In some cases, a **letter of eligibility for the Wage Subsidy** could be provided to you by your assistance officer to help you in your job search.
