Job offers are the sole source of information used to build the list of occupations in demand*. These job offers for the Nord-du-Québec region are taken from the **Online Placement service** accessible through eploiquebec.gouv.qc.ca and from newspapers. Occupations in demand may be related to seasonality or high labour turnover.

Building a list of occupations in demand improves our employability measures by analyzing the short-term needs of the labour market in the region. By providing a semi-annual overview of job prospects, Emploi-Québec gives businesses the opportunity to fill their vacant positions as soon as possible.

In 2013, the Nord-du-Québec region ranked second in terms of mining investments throughout Québec. Although our region has the lowest number of workers among the three largest mining regions, with 14.2 % of jobs, it is the source of more than half of new jobs in this industry, which is a vital part of Québec's economy. 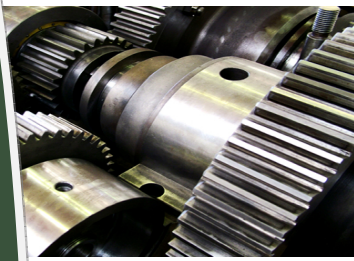
