Focusing on occupations in demand

Job offers are the sole source of information used to build the list of occupations in demand*. These job offers for the Nord-du-Québec taken from the region are **Placement** Online service accessible through emploiquebec.gouv.gc.ca and from newspapers. Occupations in demand may be related to seasonality or hight labour turnover.

Building a list of occupations in demand improves our employability measures by analyzing the short-term needs of the labour market in the region. By providing a semi-annual overview of job prospects, Emploi-Québec gives businesses the opportunity to fill their vacant positions as soon as possible.

Vitality of the resource sector

The Nord-du-Québec region showed an increase of 1,700 jobs in 2015 compared to 2014. Goods producing industries accounted for 14,200 jobs in the Nord-du-Québec region, a 26.8% rise. So construction (+10.7%), manufacturing (29.2%) and other goods industries (36.1%) saw growth in their level of employment. The service sector experienced a 3.4% drop in employment, for a loss of 1,300 jobs. This decline is a consequence of problems in retail trade, accommodation and food services and other services that have been deprived of 3,700 jobs, or 22.6%. In contrast, production services and government services respectively gained 500 and 1,900 jobs.
